The month of

Alhamdulillah, another Islamic year is coming to an end. However, we must remember that the first few days of Zul Hijjah, hold a great deal of significance.

The first ten days of Zul Hijjah are among the most significant days in the Islamic

calendar. The Prophet Muhammad has said, 'one fast during these days is equal to the fasting of the complete year, and the worship of one night, during this period, is equal to the worship of the night of power (Laylatul Qadr)'. As Muslims it is incumbent upon us, to use this time appropriately and perform as much ibaadat as we can.

The 9th of Zul Hijjah is known as the day of Arafah. Where the Hujjaj gather on the plains of Arafah and perform the one of the most important acts of Hajj. As for those who are not performing Hajj, it is Mustahab to fast on this day. The fast of

this day is a means of forgiveness for sins committed in the year.

From the Fajr of the 9th of Zul Hijjah up to the Asr Salaah of the 13th, it is obligatory on each male Muslim to recite the Takbir;

اللهُ اَكْبُرُ اللهُ اَكْبُرُ اللهُ اَكْبُرُ لَا إِلٰهَ إِلاَّ اللهُ وَاللهُ اَكْبُرُ اللهُ اَكْبُرُ

For both males and females it is obligatory to recite the Takbir on the aforementioned days, after every Fardh salaah. Whether praying in congregation or individually. Males must recite in a loud voice, whereas women must recite in a low voice..

Within these days, many of us have seen our butchers advertising prices of Sheep, Lamb etc. Islam is a unique religion. Our festivals are not based on baseless occasions/thoughts. However, Allah ﷺ has ordained
Qurabani, because of the sacrifice of Hadhrat Ibrahim ﷺ. Eid
ul Fitr is celebrated, on the
completion of the obligatory
fasts of Ramadhan.

At this time of year we learn that sacrifice is the key to our success.

We hope and pray to Allah subthat he makes this month a means of our Salvation and the entire Ummah.



Purification of the Heart, Part 2—Backbiting and its cure

In the previous issue we had explained what Tasawwuf was, to remove bad habits and develop good ones. This will purify ones soul and lead him onto the path of eternal success. Amongst the defects of the internal character is Backbiting. Such a poison, which everyone of us today is involved in, directly and in directly. Allah ** has employed such words for this illness like no other:

وَ لَا يَغْتَبُ بَعْضُكُمْ بَعْضًا، أَيْحِبُّ أَحَدُكُمْ أَنْ يَاْكُلَ لَحْمَ أَخِيْهِ مَيْنًا فَكَرِهْتُمُوْهُ Do not backbite one another. Would any of you like to eat the flesh of his brothers' dead bodie? You would detest it.

The seriousness of this illness is clear from the comparison given in the above Aayat. Anyone with the slightest amount of humanity would never perpetrate such a thing nor think about it, but the same person would backbite, whereas, Allah has given such a harsh verdict upon it.

One must realise that backbiting is worse than consuming wine, eating pork, fornicating etc. The reason be-

hind this, is that Sins such as fornicating are violating the rights of Allah and it has no relation to the rights of people. This allows the sinner to be forgiven by Allah . However backbiting is related to the rights of people. Hence, if the person who is backbitten about does not forgive you, Allah will not forgive you.

Ulama have defined backbiting as, to talk about a person behind his/her back in such a way that if they knew how he/she was remembered, they would despise it. From this definition, we should examine ourselves and see how many times we have conversed about someone in their absence and if they were to be informed regarding it, they would dislike it.

Unfortunately, those acts which are connected to the rights of people are taken very lightly even though, this could be our biggest downfall on the Day of Judgement. Hadhrat Thanwi RA mentions a prescription to abstain from backbiting. 'Do not mention anyone at all. Neither good, nor bad. Through this Shaytaan cannot trick us in mentioning good but at the same time mention something bad.

However, the main reason of backbiting is arrogance. We overlook our own faults and pin point the faults of others. If we start to worry about our own short comings and faults than this illness will automatically be cured.

Bahadur Shah Zafar narrates a couplet:

تھے جواپنی بڑائی سے بے خمر، رہے دھونتے اور ول کے عیب وھنر، یڑی اپنی بڑائ پر جو نظر، تو نگاہ اس کو سُبڑانہ رہا۔ Those who were unmindful of their own faults, look out for them in other people, but when their eyes fell on their own evils, non else was evil in their sight.

Like everything in life, the result depends on the way it is used. In the same way if the tongue is used for the remembrance of Allah SWT, we shall be rewarded. Such as; one tree in Jannah for every Subhaanallah. In the same way if we do not abstain from backbiting it can become a means to Hell.

Therefore the road to security and salvation lies in safeguarding the tongue. We must exercise to control our tongue and supplicate to Allah ﷺ to keep us away from it. It is narrated:

هَلْ يَكُبُّ النَّاسَ فِي النَّارِ إِلَّا حَصَائِدُ أَلْسِنَتِهِمْ

People will not be taken into hell fire except through the produce of their tongue.

Importance of Qurbani

Qurbani itself has many virtues. First and for most let us not forget that although we are sacrificing an animal in the name of Allah & we ourselves, reap it's benefits. It is

mentioned in a narration of the Prophet that for every animal which is sacrificed at the time of Qurbani, Allah will reward us for each hair on that animal. Let us not forget, that to consume the Qurbani meat, is a Sunnah alone. In addition to this, Allah did not ordain the entire animal to be given in the Path of Allah however it is encouraged for one to keep some for him too.

There is nothing more dearer to Allah & during the days of Qurbani than the sacrificing of animals. The sacrificed animals will be weighed on the Day of Judgment and the equivalent amount of reward will be added into a persons account.

Furthermore, Allah 🚟 places Barakah in a persons wealth through Qurbani.

PA PATH

Qurbani is obligatory on every sane, mature (reached the age of puberty), male and female who have the financial capacity to do so. i.e. he has an excess of £228. If the aforementioned criteria is fulfilled, one MUST pay for his own Qurbani, a 3rd person cannot fulfil this action

The meat of Qurbani can be given to relatives and friends whether wealthy or poor, Muslim or non-Muslim. It is preferred for it to be divided into 3 parts; one for the family, the second part for relatives, and the last part for the poor and needy. The Qurbani must be carried out, anytime after the Eid Salaah on the 10th until the sunset of the 12th of the Qurbani will be invalid.

Furthermore, it is better to choose the animal and slaughter it yourself. However, due to Food and Hygiene Laws this may prove to be difficult. So, one may speak to their local butcher and book an animal through them.

By the grace of Allah ﷺ, we are coming to the end of the Islamic year, Allah ﷺ mentions in the Quran;

إِنَّ عِدَّةَ الشُّهُوْرِ عِنْدَ اللهِ إِنَّنَا عَشَرَ شَهْرًا فِيْ كِتَابِ اللهِ يَوْمَ حَلَقَ السَّمُواتِ وَالْأَرْضِ مِنهَا اَرْبَعَةٌ حُرُمٌ، ذٰلِكَ الدِّيْنُ الْقَيِّمُ

Allah has fixed twelve months from the day He created the skies and the earth. However, from amongst the twelve months, four are regarded as The Sanctified Months. It is incumbent upon every Muslim to regard these months with sanctity and reverence. These months are Zul Qadah, Zul Hijjah, Muharram and Rajab.

The Islamic Calendar commences with Muharram. This month has certain merits and provides us with many opportunities to gain the pleasure of Allah , which is our ultimate goal in life. Amongst these opportunities are the fasts of Muharram. It is narrated in a hadith on the authority of Abu Hurairah ...

عن ابي هريرة رضي الله عنه قال، قال رسول الله صلى الله عليه وسلم: 'افضل الصيام بعد رمضان شهر الله المحرم و افضل الصلوة بعد الفريضة صلوة اليل.

رواه مسلم.

'The most superior fasts after Ramadhan is the month of Allah, Muharram and the most superior salaah after the obligatory salaah is the night salaah i.e. Tahajjud.'

However, there is a certain date that has been mentioned specifically. Imam Muslim R.A writes in his saheeh on the authority of Abu Qatadah & that the Messenger of

Allah was asked regarding the fast of

Ashura. He replied, "It is an atonement for the past year". It is also mentioned in another narration that the fasts of Ashura were obligatory upon previous nations. However, when the fasts of Ramadhan were ordained this was abrogated.

The reason behind observing the Fasts of Ashura is that on this day Musa Walland his nation miraculously crossed the Red Sea whilst fleeing from the Pharaoh. Due to this the Jews would fast on this day. Upon learning this, the

Prophet ordained the Muslims to not only fast on the 10th but to include another consecutive day; either the 9th or the 11th, because we have more of a connection with Musa and so that we distinguish ourselves.

Unfortunately, there are many incorrect beliefs regarding Muharram which have no support from authentic sources. Amongst them are the beliefs that on this day Adam was created, Ibrahim was born on this day, and that whoever bathes on this day will never fall ill. From the false practises are the lamentation ceremonies held in memory of Hussain , which are totally contradictory to the Sunnah and have no authentic sources supporting it, but rather there are Ahaadith refuting this.

As Muharram is a blessed month, we should try our utmost to gain the pleasure of Allah ...
The commentators have written that the shariah of all the prophets were unanimous upon the fact that any good deed carried out in this month is multiplied. It is up to us, as to how much we would like to invest for our Aakhirah.

As students of knowledge, we have been titled as the Inheritors of The Prophets, so it is only right that we bring the Sunnah of the Prophet

into our lives. Shaytaan and our nafs will

try to hinder and stop us from acting upon this Sunnah (especially if Ashura falls on Biryani day!). However, our sacrifices should be done for the sake of Allah bearing in mind that we will be rewarded, provided they are done with sincerity.

May Allah $\mbox{\em \%}\mbox{\em grant}$ us the ability to understand the importance of this month.

The Mis-conception; Imam Abu Hanifah RA

The Muslim Ummah is united that Imam A'zam, Abu Hanifah Nu'man ibn Thabit (may Allah have mercy upon him) is one of the four, followed imams — Malik, al-Shafi'i, Ahmad, being the other three..

Among those issues upon which all Scholars from both the early and latter times are unanimous upon, is that these four jurists, only derived figh issues (masa'il) and Shari'ah rulings from the Quran and the Sunnah of His Prophet. These two sources help towards consensus (ijma') and legal analogy (al-qiyas al-shar'i).

Knowledge the of Quran and Sunnah are the basis of deriving rules. The *mujtahid* jurists were leaders in the knowledge of Qur'an and the.

Which enabled them to derive rulings, because without these two core sciences it would be impossible for them to carry out *iitihad*.

If they did not have the knowledge of the Qur'an and the pure Sunnah, then how would they have been able to carry out *ijtihad*? How would they have been able to derive Shar'i rulings and from where would they bring these *masa'il*?

It is because of this, that when any person is designated as a *mujtahid*, then it is inevitable that, this person has a large amount and great portion of knowledge and understanding of the Qur'an and Sunnah, such that he is able to perform *ijtihaad*.

However, in spite of all of this, we see some people speaking falsely, regarding the *Imam* of the *fuqaha* and *mujtahids*, Imam Abu Hanifah Nu'man, the great *tabi'i*. They falsely say, "Surely, he had no knowledge of the Sunnah and the ahadith of the Noble Prophet (and, even if he did, then it was very little).

The evil of telling tales..

Hammad ibn Salimah narrates: a man decided to purchase a particular slave. The owner agreed to sell him the slave, but warned, "he ahs one evil quality; he carries tales." the buyer regarded this as a minor evil and agreed to the purchase.

After the slave had been in his new employment for some time, he approached his master's wife and said, "your Husband does not love you. He is silently contemplating a second marriage. Would you like him to abandon his quest for a second wife and love you exclusively?"

"Yes". She replied.

He continued, "Do as I tell you take a razor and, when he is asleep at night, cut a few strands of hair from his beard. Bring them to me so that I may cast a spell upon them which will reignite his love for you."

'D you who believe! If an evil person comes to you with any news, verify it, or else you may harm people in ignorance, and thereafter you would become regretful over what you have done." سورة الحجرات
